



Globetrotters

This is a three-year project (ending Easter 2009) offering a FREE after school club for primary schools. The club provides fun and interesting activities on global themes.

Each week the Globetrotters Club 'visits' a country and looks in more detail at an issue such as Fairtrade, conflict or environmental sustainability. Six activities are jointly delivered with a teacher and in the seventh session the club prepares an assembly for the rest of the school.

WEDG has worked with three schools each year and a Handbook will be produced at the end of the project, supported by professional development training that will enable teachers to run the club independently.
